
Dear Sir:


This was to be filed for consideration at the hearing of the application on August 21. I assume that this hearing was held on August 21 and that action was taken on the application.

Gentlemen:

I represent Mr. W. H. Ritchey, owner of the 40 acres to the North adjacent to the tract upon which the Commission approved the unorthodox location of Williams & Reed No. 6 State Well by its order dated October 15, 1951, this matter having been submitted to the Commission on August 21, 1951, taken under advisement and the order made on October 15, 1951.

As I understand the rules and regulations of the Commission, Petition for Rehearing must be filed within twenty days from the date of the order. This order was not mailed to me until so late that I did not receive it until November 7, more than twenty days from the date the order bears, October 15, 1951. Mr. Ritchey has requested that I take steps to ask for a rehearing, and inasmuch as I was not supplied with a copy of the order of October 15 until the expiration of twenty days thereafter, I would like to ask permission for an enlargement or extension of the time in this case to file a petition for rehearing upon Mr. Ritchey's behalf.

Copy of this letter is being sent to Attorneys Archer & Dillard, attorneys for Williams & Reed, at Artesia, New Mexico.

I trust that the Commission may see fit to enlarge this time under the circumstances which, if the twenty days' rule is invoked, would have the effect of denying the petition for rehearing.

May I hear from you at your earliest opportunity by return air



Please file this petition, and I would appreciate your advising what action is taken by the Commission after its consideration of the same.




