The State of New Mexico by its Oil Conservation Commission hereby gives notice pursuant to law and the rules and regulations of said Commission promulgated thereunder of the following hearings to be held November 20, 1951, beginning at 10 a.m. on that day at Mabry Hall (the new capital office building) in the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico.

State of New Mexico vs:

All named parties and persons having any right, title, interest or claim in the following cases, and notice to the public.

Case 323:

In the matter of the application of the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion for an order for the extension of existing pools, consolidation of existing pools, or the creation of new pools in Lea, Eddy, and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, as follows:

- (a) To consolidate the existing Brunson (Ellenburger) and North Brunson (Ellenburger) pools in Lea County, New Mexico, into a single pool, to be known as the Brunson (Ellenburger) pool, and to correct Order R-92.
- (b) To extend the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, to include the S/2 of Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.
- (c) To extend the Langlie-Hattix pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to include the E/2 of Section 35, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.
- (d) To extend the Denton-Wolfcamp pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to include all of Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.
- (e) To extend the Crossroads (Pennsylvanian) pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to include the W/2 Section 28, all Section 29, E/2 Section 30, all in Township 9 South, Range 36 East.
- (f) To create a new pool, to be designated as the North Cary pool, to include the W/2 SW/4 Section 28, and the W/2 NW/4 Section 33, all in Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico; or, in the alternative, to extend the McCannak pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to include the SW/4 Section 28, and the NW/4 Section 33, all in Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.
- (g) To extend the Paddock (Pennsylvanian) pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to include the NW/4 Section 23, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.
- (h) To create a new pool to include all of Sections 28, 29, 32 and 33, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, and all of Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, Township 25 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Suggested name: West Dollarhide.

CASE 324:

In the matter of the application of The Texas Company for an order approving an unorthodox location for its State AR Well No. 1, 660 feet south of the north line and 1980 feet east of the west line of Section 2, Township 11 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and for unitization for proration purposes of Lot 3, Section 2, Township 11 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, comprising 18.52 acres, more or less.

CASE 3251

In the matter of the application of Benson & Montin for approval of an unorthodox well location for its Benson-Montin Well No. 6, Gallegos Canyon Unit, 1340 feet north of the south line and 1110 feet east of the west line of Section 22, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

CASE 3261

In the matter of the application of Phillips Petroleum Company for an order establishing an unorthodox gas unit for its C. D. Woolverth Group 3 Well No. 1, SW/4 SW/4 of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, in the Cooper-Jal pool, Lea County, New Mexico, producing from the Upper Seven Rivers Formation, seeking an exception to Commission Rule 104, Paragraph (d) (Revision No. 1) and establishing, as a producing unit, lands in SW/4 NW/4, SW/4 SW/4, and S/2 S/2 Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

CASE 3271

In the matter of the petition of Phillips Petroleum Company for an exception to Commission Rule 309, "Central Tank Batteries," to permit it to produce twelve wells on its Santa Fe Lease, W/2 Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, into one consolidated tank battery.

CASE 3281


In the matter of the application of the Commission, upon its own motion, for an order directed to Al Parker and the Maryland Casualty Company, declaring the Al Parker State No. 1 well, located in NW/4 SE/4 Section 15, Township 23 South, Range 5 East, NMPM, Dona Ana County, New Mexico, abandoned and ordering it plugged, and directing said Al Parker and the Maryland Casualty Company to appear before the Oil Conservation Commission at 10 a.m. November 20, 1951, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, and show cause why such order should not issue.

CASE 3291

In the matter of the application of Witco Carbon Company (formerly Panhandle Carbon Co., Inc.) for an order to remove any limitation as to source from which gas may be obtained to allow the right to use gas from such other source as casinghead gas may from time to time be available; to amend Order No. 724 by eliminating provisions whereby the Commission retained jurisdiction to determine from time to time the higher economic use of such gas for domestic and repressuring purposes; and to extend authority granted by Order No. 724 to August 8, 1966, and other matters.
