Dear Jason:

I am in receipt of a copy of form C-123 from the Magnolia Petroleum Company requesting that a new pool named the North Cary Pool be created for their Carson 16-D, 33-21-37. On the basis of the information in our files, however, I believe the Commission should consider the extension of the McCormack Pool to include the W/2 Section 33 T. 21-37.

The McCormack pool as it now exists includes the E/2 Section 29 and all of Section 32. Located within this pool are two wells, the Stanolind Oil & Gas Company Turner 3-F, 29-21-37 and the Gulf McCormack 11-A, 32-21-37. The Magnolia Carson #16 is located 860 feet from the boundary and is apparently producing from the same formation according to the information listed below.
