S. J. STANLEY,

having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. WHITE:

Q. Mr. Stanley will you state your name and position for the record?

A. Stanley John Stanley, engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission, Hobbs, New Mexico.

Q. Have you had occasion to make a study of the proposed extensions and deletions as advertised in Case 571?

A. Yes, I have.

Q. Will you report to the Commission your findings?

A. I recommend that all the deletions and extensions be made as advertised. In support of my testimony, I would like to present a plat.
