C O M P L E T I O N   D A T A

Skelly Oil Company's Mexico "W" well No. 1, located 660' from each the South and East lines of the lease and section was completed June 14, 1954. Connection was obtained from Permian Basin Pipeline Company August 11, 1954.

The well was drilled to a total depth of 4065' in the Seven Rivers formation. 7" OD casing was set at 3810' and the plug drilled out to 3890'. The open hole interval 3810 - 3890' was acidized with 30 gallons acid ahead of a 10,000 gallon Sandoil treatment. Well never produced all of load oil, but was water free.

Well plugged back to 3800' with Model "N" Baker bridging plug with Calseal plug from 3800 - 3793'. The well was perforated from 3728 - 3738' and the perforations treated with 6000 gallons Sandfrac. These perforations tested at 5,510 MCFPD @ 125 psi back pressure.

The well was then perforated from 3676 - 3690' and treated with 6000 gallons Sandfrac. This zone tested at 2,000 MCFPD.

Both perforated intervals listed above are now open and the 72 hour shut in tubing pressure is 1227.2 psia.




