Dear Bob:

I am setting out below an application which reflects my ideas for the calling of the hearing to require reporting of cement jobs by service companies.

Application of the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion for an order requiring the various oil well cementing service companies to report monthly on all cementing operations performed in the State of New Mexico.

Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order requiring a monthly report to be filed by every service company involved in the cementing of oil wells in the State of New Mexico. Such report would be as complete as is practical, and would include all pertinent information dealing with each individual cementing job performed by the reporting company.

I am sure that you can smooth this out, and any revision you would like to make will be fine with me. I believe that a broad general "call" for the hearing will allow us to put on the necessary testimony and to introduce any exhibits that we find are needed.

I believe that we should have a form prepared for the hearing along the lines we discussed the other day, and I will make one for you to check. However, I think it makes no difference whether the report is on a Commission form or one regularly used by the individual service companies.
