MR. PORTER: Do you think there will be a possibility of additional information by that time, Mr. Runyon?

MR. RUNYON: Yes, sir, there should be.

MR. PORTER: Is there any objection to Mr. Runyon's motion for continuance of this case? It will be continued to the regular January, 1957 hearing.

MR. WALKER: Let the record show that Mr. Runyon was the same Mr. Runyon that testified in Case 1166.

MR. PORTER: Is there anything else to come before the Commission? The hearing stands adjourned.
