Dear Mr. Porter:

Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation is the operator of San Juan Unit 32-7 which covers land in Townships 32 and 31 North, Range 7 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. Because of a variation in the legal sub-division several sections in these townships contain less than the prescribed 640 acres.

Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation has devised a plan to establish fifteen non-standard gas proration units so that the proposed Mesa Verde Wells may be more equally spaced on the established sections, range and township lines and their legal subdivisions.

Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission hold an Examiner's Hearing at the earliest possible date, preferably in Farmington, New Mexico, so a request may be made to take exception to Order R-128 D, Rule 1, for the establishment of non-standard gas proration units and to take exception to Order R-110, Rule 1-C as amended by Order R-397 and grant the required unorthodox locations on the approved non-standard proration units.

Attached is a copy of Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation's proposed plan.
