My recommendations for an order in the above numbered cases are as follows:

Enter an order authorizing the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, to dually complete its Naomi Keenum Well No. 2 located 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 37 East. Said well shall be completed for the production of oil from the Terry Blinebry Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool through parallel strings of tubing. Applicant proposes to flow the Blinebry oil through 2 inch Hydrill "A" J-55 tubing and to flow the Tubb gas through  $1\frac{1}{4}$  inch NU J-55 tubing. Applicant further proposes to use a Baker Model "A" parallel anchor flow tube. While this type of equipment has never previous to this time been approved by the Commission, it is believed that it will provide an adequate and effective means of separation of the fluids from the two reservoirs. The oil produced from the Terry Blinebry can be pumped to the surface if necessary.
