ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 18, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 23 sd day of February, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Justis-Ellenburger Pool, the Justis-Montoya Pool, and the Maljamar Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico; and to the Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, the West Henshaw-Grayburg Pool, and the Red Lake-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico; and to the Acme Pool and the Caprock-Queen Pool, both in Chaves County, New Mexico; and to the North Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Acme Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:
