Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Commission Order R-1530, which classified Mumble's New Mexico State "V" Well No. Il as a gas well in the Tubb Gas Pool and which requested that Mumble conduct a series of tests to help determine whether such classification should be on a temporary or a permanent basis.

We are in receipt of your letter of December 29, with which you enclosed a tabulation of the results of these tests.

In our opinion the tests have failed to show that the classification as a gas well should be extended. On the other hand, they have also failed to show any real evidence that the classification should be changed.

We therefore believe that it would be advisable to continue the present classification of the Humble New Mexico State "V" Well No. 11, Tubb Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as a gas well in said pool for at least one more year, during which time Humble should continue to take

menthly tests similar to those which have previously been conducted.
