APPLICATION OF TRACO INC. FOR A "SLIN-HOLE" OIL-GAS DEAL COMPLETION IN AN UN-DESIGNATED GALLET OIL FOOL AND IN THE DARDER PRODUCING INTERVAL, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE CONCLESION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on September 7, 1960, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Uts, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Counission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Counission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Counission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this /o # day of September, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public motice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Texaco Inc., is the owner and operator of the H. J. Loe Federal "B" Well No. 3, located in Unit M, Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, MCPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the said H. J. Loe Pederal "B" Well No. 3 in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup oil pool and the production of gas from the Dakota Producing Interval through parallel strings of 2-3/8 inch casing and 4-1/2 inch easing, respectively, commuted in a common well bore. Applicant proposes to produce the Dakota gas through 2-3/8 inch tubing installed within the 4-1/2 inch easing.

- (4) That in order to protect the productive horizons, communished extend from total depth to a point 600 feet above the top of the Gallup formation, and from a depth of 1700 feet to a point 200 feet above the top of the Pictured Cliffs formation.
- (5) That centralizers or turbelizers should be installed at 30-foot intervals throughout the Dahota, Gallup, and Pictured Cliffs formations and to a point 100 feet above said formations.
- (6) That the machanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.
- (7) That approval of the subject application will meither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE CEDERED:

That the applicant, Texaco Inc., he and the same is hereby authorised to dually complete its H. J. Los Federal "B" Well Mo. 3, located in Unit H. Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, MOPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup oil pool through 2-3/8 inch easing and the production of gas from the Baheta Producing Interval through 2-3/8 inch tubing installed within a parallel string of 4-1/2 inch easing communed in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That coment shall extend from total depth to a point 600 feet above the top of the Gallup formation, and from a depth of 1700 feet to a point 200 feet above the top of the Pictured Cliffs formation.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That centralisers or turbolisers shall be installed at 30-feet intervals throughout the Dakota, Gallup, and Pistured Cliffs formations and to a point 100 feet above said formations.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the applicant shall take communication tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Producing Interval

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or the protection of correlative rights; upon failure of the applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority herein granted and require the applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-mone production in the interest of conservation.
