Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for the Abo formation, Eddy County, New Mexico, at a point 1160 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 28 East for its Hondo-Western-Yates Well No. 38-A.

CASE 2123: Application of Continental Oil Company for an unorthodox oil well location. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its William Mitchell "A" Well No. 21 in the Maljamar-Paddock Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, at a point 1345 feet from the North line and 2615 feet from the West line of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 32 East.
