TV-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool

Dear Mr. Porter:

The above Order created the TV-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and established 320 acre gas proration units on a temporary basis. It provided that the case should be called for hearing before the Commission at its regular monthly hearing in December of 1961, at which time the operators should appear and show cause why 160 acre proration units should not be established.

Robinson Brothers, who were the applicants in the case have no strong feelings one way or another as to having the matter heard before the full Commission or before an Examiner. In view of the fact that the pool is very small it does not appear to me to be a policy case, and if you feel that the full Commission cannot afford the time, we certainly have no objection to having the matter heard by an Examiner. I doubt that it will be a long case as there is very little additional evidence or information. Frankly, I do not know at this point whether we will request permanent rules or ask a further temporary order. Under either circumstance, I do not believe the case will be lengthy.
