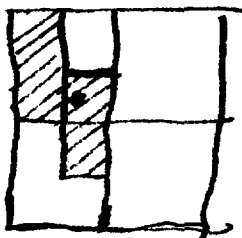

Gentlemen:

Texaco Inc. respectfully requests that a hearing be set to consider its application for an unorthodox well location, a 160-acre non-standard proration unit, and a slim hole completion for its L. M. Barton No. 1 located in the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

In support of its application, Texaco Inc. wishes to state the following facts:


1. It is proposed to complete the L. M. Barton Well No. 1 at a location 1850' FNL and 1650' FWL of Section 12, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.
2. The location of the well will be unorthodox in that it will not be located in either the Northeast or the Southwest quarter of the Section.
3. The 160-acre non-standard proration unit will consist of the W/2 of the NW/4, the SE/4 of the NW/4 and the NE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 12, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.



4. The well will be completed as a dual producer between the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota Gas Pools. The casings shall consist of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inch and  $2\frac{7}{8}$  inch casing cemented in a common bore hole. The Blanco Mesaverde will be produced through the  $2\frac{7}{8}$  inch casing.

IT IS RESPECTFULLY REQUESTED that this application be set for hearing on the first examiner hearing scheduled in July, 1961.
