### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 4, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 13th day of October, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Hondo Oil & Gas Company, seeks permission to directionally drill a well to be located 2310 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
  - (3) That the applicant intends to directionally drill said well in such a manner as to bottom the well 100 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 26.
- (4) That Pan American Petroleum Corporation and Sinclair Oil & Gas Company seek the dismissal of the applicant's request due to the failure of the application and advertisement to specify that said well would be bottomed at an unorthodox location in said Section 36.
  - (5) That Case No. 2394 should be <u>dismissed</u> without prejudice to the applicant.
