Please be advised that The Frontier Refining Company has, on numerous occasions, notified Skelly Oil Company that Frontier leases producing from the Gallegos-Gallup Pool will not be committed to the proposed Gallegos-Gallup Sand Unit. However, Skelly continues to include these leases within the proposed unit.

Frontier has further informed Skelly that, in our opinion, the formula used for determining percentage participation in the proposed unit is not equitable.
