This is to advise that your application for administrative approval of the dual completion of your New Mexico State "BO" Well No. 1, Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, to produce from the Drinkard and Abo formations has been set for hearing before one of the Commission's examiners at 9 o'clock a.m., April 11, 1962, in Santa Fe.

This was done because some question has arisen as to whether the Drinkard and Abo pays actually constitute separate reservoirs or may in fact all be one common source of supply.

We would suggest that Humble should be prepared to show such separation both on a geological as well as engineering basis.
