Gentlemen:

In accordance with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule No. 107, Texaco Inc. respectfully requests that a hearing be set to consider its application to complete the State of New Mexico "AT" Well No. 5 as a tubingless completion at a depth greater than 5000'. In support of this application the following facts are submitted:

1. Texaco Inc. is the operator of the State of New Mexico "AT" lease consisting of the S/2 of the S/2 of Section 10 and all of Section 15, T-14-S, R-33-E, Lea County, New Mexico and containing 800 acres more or less.
2. The State of New Mexico "AT" Well No. 5 is located in Unit M, 660' from the south line and 660' from the west line of Section 10, T-14-S, R-33-E.
3. The completion does not qualify for administrative approval since it is an exception to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 107 (e) (1) in that the subject well is completed at a depth greater than 5000'.
4. A production casing string will consist of a string of 2-7/8" OD casing set at approximately 10,000'.
5. The well will be completed in the Wolfcamp formation through casing perforations 9735' to 9950'.

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6. It is anticipated that the Wolfcamp completion will be oil and will flow initially.

Attached in triplicate is a plat showing the State of New Mexico "AT" lease and the location of Well No. 5. Also shown on the plat are the offset operators and their mailing addresses. It is requested that this application be set for hearing on the first available examiner hearing docket.
