APPLICATION

Comes now SHELL OIL COMPANY by its attorneys, SETH, MONTGOMERY, FEDERICI & ANDREWS, and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for permission to dually complete its Henshaw Deep Unit Well No. 5, and in support thereof states:

1. That Shell Oil Company is the owner and operator of the Henshaw Deep Unit Well No. 5, located 660 feet from the North and East lines of Section 23, Township 16 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. That the applicant proposes to complete said well as a dual completion (conventional) in the Wolfcamp and Devonian formations, with production from both zones to be through 2 3/8-inch tubing. Oil production is anticipated from both zones, but gas may be encountered in the Devonian. In this regard, please note that the Henshaw-Devonian Gas Pool covers the NW/4 of Section 24 adjoining the subject well.

3. That, inasmuch as the subject well has not been completed, applicant requests an Order of the Commission authorizing the production of either oil or gas from the Devonian formation.

4. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are in accord with sound conservation practices, and approval of this application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks permission to complete its Henshaw Deep Unit Well No. 5, located 660 feet from the North and East Lines of Section 23, Township 16 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) in such manner as to permit the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation adjacent to the Henshaw-Wolfcamp Pool and the production of oil or gas, whichever is encountered, from the Devonian formation adjacent to the Henshaw-Devonian Gas Pool, with production from both zones to be through strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing.
