My recommendations for an order in the above numbered cases are as follows:

Enter an order approving  
Acme Mobil's dual completion  
(conventional) of its State Bridges #27-DD  
H-26-17S-34E to produce  
oil from the Vacuum (Grayburg-  
San Andres Pool and the Paddock  
formation through parallel strings  
of  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " OD X 2" OD Buttress Thread  
tubing and  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " OD X ~~1.38~~" 1.38" ID  
tubing respectively. Separation by  
~~packer~~ @ approx 6360'.  
Packer leakage tests upon  
completion of annually thereafter  
during Paddock GOR test period.  
Provide that similarly equipped dual  
completions of these same two reservoirs  
within one mile of this well or within one  
mile of a similarly equipped and pre-  
viously approved either administratively  
or after hearing shall be eligible for  
administrative approval.
