Re: Proposed South Seven Rivers Unit Area, Eddy County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Franco Western Oil Company, a Delaware Corporation, with a permit to do business in the State of New Mexico, and with an office at 806 Wilco Building, Midland, Texas, hereby seeks approval of the South Seven Rivers Unit Area comprising 4479.84 acres of State, Federal and Fee lands in Township 20 South, Ranges 24 and 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Reference is made to the attached "Exhibit A" for purpose of defining the proposed Unit Area. Three copies of this letter with "Exhibit A" are furnished herewith.

- 1. Attached "Exhibit A" is plat showing:
 - a. Proposed Unit Area
 - b. Ownership of Oil and Gas Leases in Unit Area as shown of record.
 - c. Serial number of State and Federal leases listed in sequence.
 - d. Amount of State, Federal and Fee acreage and total thereof in proposed Unit.
- 2. Franco Western Oil Company is the proposed operator of the Unit.
- 3. Applicant will furnish the Commission any Geological information and/or maps it might desire upon being advised as to the information and maps the Commission might desire or require.

- 4. Applicant proposes to drill or cause to be drilled a test well to a depth of 9300 feet or a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, whichever is the lesser depth. The present proposed location for the well is in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 36, T 20 S, R 24 E.
- 5. Applicant has heretofore on September 13, 1963, filed with the Regional Supervisor of the United States Geological Survey, Roswell, New Mexico, its Application For Designation Of South Seven Rivers Unit Area, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 6. Applicant proposes to use substantially the standard form of Unit Agreement 30 C.F.R. 226.12 as revised in the 1961 reprint.

Agreement form will be changed in the following respects:

- 1. By adding provision to provide for the inclusion of State land within the proposed unit.
- 2. Insertion of nondiscrimination clause in lieu of the "Fair Employment" section in Section 26, of the 1961 reprint of the Standard Unit Agreement.
- 3. Item 6 (b) beginning on Line 5, Page 7 of the 1961 reprint to read:
 - (b) The selection shall have been filed with the Supervisor. If no successor Unit Operator is selected and qualified as herein provided, the Director at his election may declare this Unit Agreement terminated.

Applicant wishes to call the Commission's attention to the fact that Federal Leases N.M. Serial No. 071391-A and 071391-B which cover all of Section 31, T 20 S, R 25 E, are in their third term of extention and will expire October 31, 1963, and the applicant respectfully request that this application be given your preferred attention.


