Dear Mr. Long:

I have examined your Agreement form for the Proposed Cowntown Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico and find it quite acceptable as to form and content.

There are however two additions I would suggest:

Page 3, Article 3. Expansion, under line one of (2) after Commissioner add "and Commission".
Page 4, line two, second paragraph, after Commissioner add "and Commission".
Page 13, Article 35. Border Agreements, I would strike the word "supervisor" on the second line. If it seemed necessary to provide for the Supervisor's approval I would continue from the end of the paragraph and after "interests" delete the period and add "however, if the adjacent lands along the exterior boundary of the Unit Area are Federal lands that border-protection Agreements must also be approved by the Supervisor of the United States Geological Survey.

I am not familiar enough with the Federal leases to know if such an Agreement would have to be approved by the United States Geological Survey.
