FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, The British-American Oil Producing Company, seeks authority to complete its North Wilson Deep Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit O of Section 31, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) to produce oil from the _______Upper Bone Spring pool and the ______Lower Bone Spring for through parallel strings of $\frac{318}{2}$ -inch tubing, with separation of zones by a packer set at approximately /0,070 feet.

(3) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

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(4) That approval of the proposed dual completion will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
