is hereby created and designated as the Miguel Creek-  
Gallup Oil Pool consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 16 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM  
Section 29: SE/4 NW/4 and SW/4 NE/4


(2) That this order shall be effective nunc pro tunc as
