APPLICATION

SANTA FE ENERGY OPERATING PARTNERS, L.P., by its undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978) for an order pooling all of the mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing in and under the S/2 of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant owns or represents 62.5% of the working interest in and under the S/2 of Section 17, and Applicant has the right to drill thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced pooled unit to its Muskegon 17 State Com No. 1 Well located at a standard location 660 feet from the South line and 2180 feet from the West line of said Section 17, sufficient to test the Morrow formation.

3. Applicant has sought and obtained either voluntary agreement for pooling or farmout from all other interest owners in the S/2 of said Section 17, except for the following:

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
4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled, and Applicant should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on May 30, 1991, and, that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including provisions for Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well, and making such other and further provisions as may be proper.
