Conoco Inc. seeks approval for its Barbara Federal 13 well which is proposed as a high angle/horizontal/directionally drilled well in the North Dagger Draw Pool (R-4691-D).

Conoco will dedicate the NW/4 (160 acres) of Section 17, T19S, R25E, Eddy County, New Mexico to the well which is a standard sized spacing unit for this pool.

Conoco will honor the setback from the 660 foot side boundaries of the unit and will produce the well within the production limitations for this pool.
