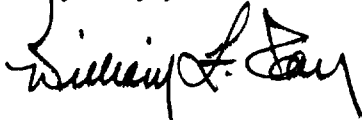

APPLICATION

COLLINS & WARE, INC., through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order pooling all of the mineral interests in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing in the S/2 of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, from a depth of 7,000 feet to the base of the Morrow formation, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant owns or represents approximately 50% of the working interest in and under the S/2 of Section 25, and Applicant has the right to drill thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing or proration unit to a well to be drilled at an orthodox location in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 25, to a depth of approximately 12,075 feet to test the Pennsylvanian formation, Culedra Bluff Pool.
3. Applicant has sought and obtained either voluntary agreement for pooling or farmout from all other interest owners in the S/2 of said Section 25, except for those working interest owners set out on Exhibit A to this application.

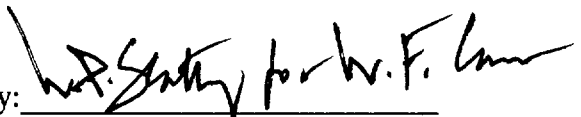
4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled, and Applicant should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 22, 1991 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including provisions for Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well.

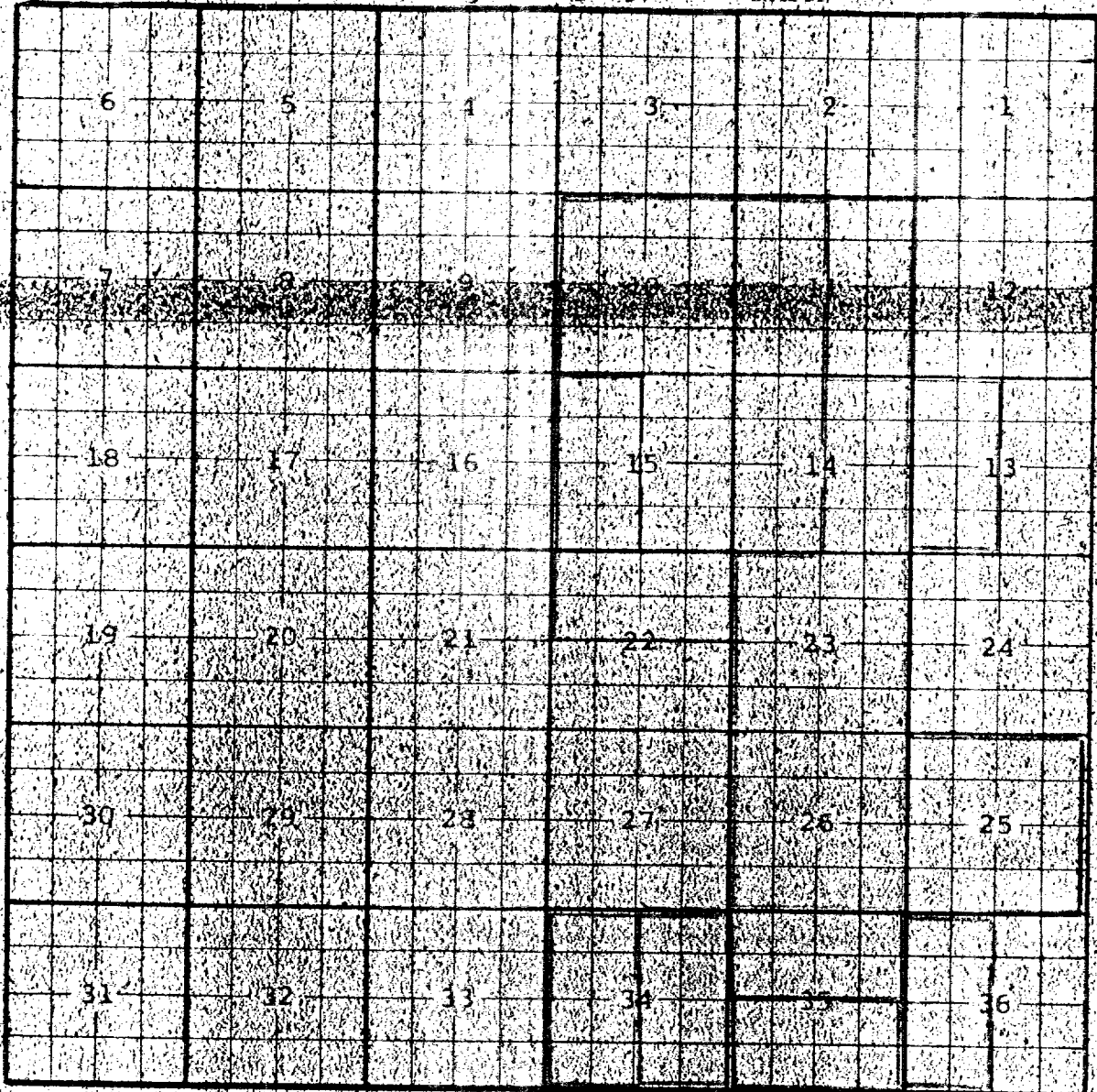
