Will the witness, please, come forward, 13 stand, and be sworn in. 14 JOE FITZGERALD 15 Having been duly sworn upon his oath, was 16 examined and testified as follows: 17 EXAMINATION 18 19 BY MR. CARR: Will you state your name for the 50 0. 21 record, please? 22 Α. Joe Fitzgerald. Where do you reside? 23 0. 24 Α. Midland, Texas. By whom are you employed and in what 25 Q.

- Q. Have you previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division?
  - A. No.
  - Q. Would you briefly summarize for Mr. Catanach your educational background and then review your work experience?
  - A. I have a PLM degree from the University of Texas, graduated in 80. I've been employed as a landman since then for Texas Oil & Gas and Arco and now Nearburg.
  - Q. Does the geographic area of your responsibility for Nearburg include the portion of southeastern New Mexico which is involved in this case?
- 17 A. Yes.
- Q. Are you familiar with the application filed in this case on behalf of Nearburg?
  - A. Yes.
  - Q. Have you made a land study of the area which is involved?
- 23 A. Yes.
- Q. Are you familiar with the proposed wells and the negotiations that have resulted in

the proposed unorthodox location? 1 Α. Yes. 2 MR. CARR: We tender Mr. Fitzgerald as 3 an expert witness in petroleum land matters. 4 5 EXAMINER CATANACH: He is so qualified. 6 Q. (BY MR. CARR) Mr. Fitzgerald, could 7 you briefly state what Nearburg seeks with this 8 application? 9 Nearburg is seeking approval of an unorthodox oil well location, Eddy County, New 10 Mexico, to drill its Emerald "32" Federal Well 11 No. 1 at an unorthodox oil well location up 2007 12 feet from the north line and 1470 feet from the 13 west line, Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 14 29 East to test the Delaware Formation. 15 Have you prepared certain exhibits for 16 17 presentation here today? Α. Yes. 18 Would you refer to what has been marked 19 Q. 20 for identification as Nearburg Exhibit No. 1, identify this, and review it for Mr. Catanach? 21 22 Α. It's a land plat for Section 32, 23 Township 24 South, Range 29 East.

We're in an undesignated Delaware.

1 Q. So this is developed under statewide rules? 2 Yes. 3 Α. Q. You're talking about a standard 40-acre 5 proration unit --Α. Yes. 6 -- in the Delaware? 7 Q. 8 Α. Yes. 9 Q. What does the orange square indicate? Our spacing unit. 10 Α. And the two dots included within that 11 Q. square? 12 13 The blue represents the legal location; the red, the unorthodox location. 14 15 Could you preview for Mr. Catanach the Q. ownership in Section 32? 16 The north half is Nearburg. The 17 southeast quarter and the northwest of the 18 southwest is Exxon Nearburg UTI Energy, Richard 19 20 K. Barr, Scott E. Wilson. And the remainder of 21 the south half is the Bettis and Enron, Bettis Brothers and Enron. 22 23 Q. Is there any other Delaware development 24 in this section? 25 A. No.

- Q. And then in what would be the northeast quarter of this plat, there are certain other individuals identified. Who are those people?
  - A. Those are people that have the right to participate in this well.
    - Q. Let's move now to Nearburg Exhibit No.
- 2. Would you identify that, please?
  - A. It's a topo map of the area showing our spacing unit, the orthodox location, and the unorthodox location. You can see by the unorthodox location there's a small knoll indicated, very small feature.
- Q. Is that the small circle just to the right of the red dot?
  - A. Yes, sir.

- Q. Okay. Also the topographical map shows
  a channel coming off the Pecos River; is that not
  correct?
  - A. Yes, sir.
  - Q. Why did you have to move from the standard location?
  - A. The BLM has put this acreage and all their acreage in this river channel area into a Pecos River Corridor Special Management Area, as provided in the Carlsbad Resource Management

- Plan. They have requested us to move it to the unorthodox location in compliance under that plan.
  - Q. So what they did was, first of all, you couldn't drill at the standard location because you're right on that river channel?
  - A. That, and also there was an archeological site found there.
    - Q. So you were required to move to the west?

- Q. You had to go this far to the west for what reason?
- A. At their request, that's where they
  said they would approve an APD at that location.
- 16 Q. That small dot just to the right of the 17 red circle is a knoll?
- 18 A. Uh-huh.
- Q. And they asked you to put this well behind a knoll so it could not be seen?
  - A. Right, and not to disturb that knoll.
  - Q. Let's go now to what has been marked as Nearburg Exhibit No. 3. Would you identify that for Mr. Catanach?
- 25 A. This is the letter from the BLM,

- Richard L. Manus, the area manager, stating that 1 2 the area is in the Pecos River Corridor; that they wish us to move the location to the 3 unorthodox location shown on the previous plat.
  - This is both to avoid contamination to the Pecos and also to avoid impact on their special management area?
    - Α. Yes.
  - Are there any geological reasons for Q. moving this location?

Were Exhibits 1 through 5 prepared by you or compiled under your direction? 18 19 Α. Yes. MR. CARR: At this time, Mr. Catanach, 20 2 1 we move the admission of Nearburg Exhibits 1 22 through 5.
