COMES NOW Nearburg Exploration Company, through its undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to N.M. Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17 for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Morrow and Cisco Canyon formations underlying the N/2 of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and for approval of an unorthodox well location, and in support thereof would show the Division:

- 1. Applicant owns or represents 50% of the working interest underlying the N/2 of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, from the surface down to 10,025 feet below the surface, and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill a well to test the Morrow and Cisco Canyon formations at a location which is 660 feet from the North line and 1330 feet from the East line of Section 27.
- 3. Applicant seeks an exception to Rule 104 to permit the drilling of the above-described unorthodox location to a depth

- 5. Said pooling of interests and approval of an unorthodox well location will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
- 6. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled, and Applicant should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 30, 1992, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands,

including provisions for Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well, approving Applicant's unorthodox well location, and making such other further provisions as may be proper.
