
Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Union Oil Company of California d/b/a UNOCAL has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the termination of gas prorating in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool located in Townships 23 through 29 North, Ranges 1 through 9 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

This application has been set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 6, 1992. As an operator of a well or unleased mineral interest owner within the boundaries of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool; the operator of a well within one mile of the boundaries of this pool, or the transporter of production therefrom, you may appear at the hearing and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time or otherwise become a party of record will preclude you from challenging this application at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases before the Division have been requested to file a Prehearing Statement substantially in the form prescribed by the Division (Oil Conservation Division Memorandum 2-90). Prehearing statements should be filed by 4:00 o'clock p.m. on the Friday before a scheduled hearing.

RE: Deprorating the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool

Dear Sirs:

Union Oil Company of California dba UNOCAL is considering application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division requesting the deproration of the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool in Rio Arriba, San Juan, and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico. The low remaining energy and tight reservoir properties of the subject pool will allow for the elimination of gas prorationing without harming correlative rights or creating waste. Additionally, the impact to the gas market would be insignificant.

With Order R1670R in 1974 the Oil Conservation Commission eliminated prorationing in four Pictured Cliffs Pools: Aztec, Ballard, Fulcher, and West Kutz. The evidence cited for deprorating was the low productivity of the wells in these respective fields. Specifically, average well production had declined to less than 100 mcf/d with over 70% of the wells producing less than 3000 mcf per month. Today, the South Blanco Pool easily meets these criteria; averaging 30 mcf/d per well with over 95% of the wells producing less than 3000 mcf per month.

The Pictured Cliffs is widely known as a low permeability gas sand. Subsequently, there is no reasonable concern for correlative rights to be threatened by drainage at this late date in the pool's life cycle.


Currently, UNOCAL is requesting support for this application from you and other operators in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool. Please carefully consider this motion and indicate if you would do one of the following:

1. Fully support such an application to deprorate the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, and would possibly present testimony at the hearing for the application;
2. Support such an application to deprorate in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool by a written statement to be attached to the application;

We are writing to support the proposed termination of prorating gas production in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs gas pool of Rio Arriba, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, as proposed in the subject application.

The South Blanco PC gas pool was discovered in June 1951 and the subject pool rules were established on May 20, 1952. As of January 1, 1992, the pool included 1,675 wells and has produced 1,058,892,824 MCF. This is a large pool and has produced a large amount of gas during the last forty years. Prorating may have been important to the producing of this pool in its early life, however, it is generally recognized among the operators in this pool that we are in the latter stages of pressure depletion and the individual well producing rates are generally low as a result of reservoir pressure that has been substantially depleted.


Dugan Production Corp. currently operates 18 wells (17 active and 1 shut-in) in the South Blanco PC pool and during June 1992, produced a total of 9,418 MCF for an overall average of 18.5 MCFD per well. Of the 17 active wells, 10 produced less than 15 MCFD (average 6.0 MCFD per well), and 7 wells produced at rates between 15 and 65 MCFD (averaging 38.5 MCFD per well). Dugan Production firmly believes that the need to prorate within the South Blanco PC gas pool no longer exists, and that in view of the low reservoir pressure and corresponding low well producing rates, the potential for any one well to create a violation of correlative rights is very low.





This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 6, 1992, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

Now, on this \_\_\_\_ day of August, 1992, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant seeks to terminate proration in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs gas pool (South Blanco-PC pool).

(3) The subject pool was created by Division Order R-152 and proration was begun in the subject pool as well as the Aztec-PC, and Fulcher Kutz-PC pools under rules promulgated by Order R-565 in March, 1955 later followed by the West Kutz-PC and Ballard-PC pools.

(4) All of said pools lie within close proximity to one another as well as the Ballard-PC and Tapacito-PC pools, which were also prorated later, and the Blanco-PC pool which was never prorated.

(5) In 1974, by order R-1670-R, Aztec, Ballard, Fulcher Kutz-PC, and West Kutz-PC pools were deproprated upon recommendation of a committee appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission, but that committee recommended against deproprating the South Blanco-PC and Tapacito-PC pools at that time.

(6) Applicant showed that the South Blanco-PC pool was the largest of the pools discussed above and showed further that the subject pool produced as much as the other pools combined.

(7) The data presented indicated that all the PC pools named above were producing less than 100 MCF/D except Blanco and Tapacito so it appears that criterion was not compelling at that time, since South Blanco-PC and Tapacito-PC remained prorated and Blanco continued as unprorated.

(8) Applicant's witness testified that the effect of extrapolating deliverability test results to a common percentage of the shut in pressure of each well discouraged efforts to stimulate production such as installation of compression, however, he was unable to show that any compression had been installed in the pools unprorated since 1974.


(9) Gas Company of New Mexico (GCNM) appeared in opposition to the application. The Hearing Examiner found that GCNM had standing in this matter.

(10) Protestant's witness testified that the proration system was changed effective April 1, 1991 from a 1-month allowable and monthly proration schedule to a six-month system with semi-annual proration schedules. Problems in the data base and computer programs have prevented generation of accurate data and precluded reclassification of wells as provided by the rules. Furthermore, the system of notifying operators of wells and their pipeline that wells were excessively overproduced and should be shut-in has been inoperative.

(11) Protestant's witness further stated that resolving the problems with the system would permit a true test of whether the new rules work as designed and could serve to alleviate the problems of low allowables of which Applicant is complaining.

(12) Protestant's witness stated this application is premature and that any action to deproprate should be deferred until a properly operating prorationing system indicates a continuing problem.

(13) Protestant presented testimony that there have been times in the past, such as in May, 1981 when all prorated pools in the state had much fewer non-marginal wells than there are at present and there was no request for deproprating at those times and that in



May 1981 the subject pool had only 80 non-marginal wells whereas at the present time there are 326, or 17% of the wells in the pool, sp classified.

(14) Protestant's witness further recalled that as recently as 1986 conditions in the industry caused market demand to drop precipitously such that a majority of the wells in the prorated gas pools in the San Juan Basin became non-marginal, and mentioned that coal-seam methane gas is the largest single source of gas in the state and could well decrease the market of conventional gas in the San Juan Basin, including conventional gas from the South Blanco-PC pool.

(15) Applicant's Exhibit indicated that upon termination of prorating gas supply (from capable wells currently capped by allowables) would increase, however there was no evidence that overall demand for gas from the San Juan Basin would increase to accumulate the increased supply.

(16) There was no showing that gas demand exceeded gas supply either in this pool or in the state as a whole, and that termination of prorating for the South Blanco-PC would not result in unreasonable discrimination between pools.





(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Union Oil Company of California d/b/a Unocal ("Unocal"), seeks an Order terminating gas prorationing in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and excluding this pool from the provisions of the General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico as set forth in Division Order No. R-8170, as amended.

(3) The South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool was created by Division Order No. R-156 which was entered in May, 1952 and has been expanded from time to time to include portions of Townships 23 through 29 North, Ranges 1 through 9 West, Rio Arriba, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

(4) By Order No. R-565 dated December 23, 1954, as subsequently amended, the Division adopted Special Pool Rules for the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and other pools in the San Juan Basin, and provided for the prorationing of gas from these pools.

(5) By memorandum dated November 14, 1973, the Secretary-Director of the Oil Conservation Commission appointed an industry committee to study the Pictured gas pools and to make recommendations concerning the possible elimination of gas prorationing in these pools.

(6) The Division entered Order No. R-1670-R on February 7, 1974 adopting the unanimous recommendation of the industry committee which concluded that prorationing should be terminated in four Pictured Cliffs pools because the productivity of these pools had declined to an average per well production rate of approximately 100 mcf per day and at these low production rates waste would not be caused nor correlative rights impaired. (OCD Order No. R-1670-F; Findings 9, 10, 11 and 12).

(7) Although the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool had production rates which were comparable to or below the production rates of the pools in which prorationing was terminated in 1974, prorationing was continued in that pool because there were unequal pipeline pressures between competing pipelines in the pool and under those circumstances there was concern that the termination of prorationing could result in nonratable takes. (Transcript of OCD hearing in Case No. 5154).

(8) The evidence demonstrated that the problems of nonratable takes because of unequal pressures between pipelines in the pool no longer exists for the wells in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool are in an advanced state of pressure depletion and can only produce into the low pressure gathering systems in the pool.

(9) Production rates for wells in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool have continued to decline from an average rate of 69 mcf per day in 1973 to an average rate of 24 mcf per day in 1991.

(10) The South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool is now a low productivity reservoir in an advanced state of depletion.

(11) The evidence established that this is a low permeability reservoir in an advanced state of depletion and that no well in this pool should drain in excess of 160-acres and therefore the correlative rights of no interest owner in this pool should be impaired by the termination of prorationing.

(12) Termination of prorationing in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool will encourage efficient production practices in this pool, will eliminate a disincentive to the addition of compression to wells in this pool thereby increasing the ultimate recovery of gas from the pool thereby preventing waste.

(13) There is no curtailment of natural gas production in the San Juan Basin at this time due to limited market demand.

(14) Under current market conditions there is no market demand reason to continue to prorate the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

(15) Gas Company of New Mexico appeared at the hearing and presented its concerns about the current status of the prorating system but did **not** recommend that this application be denied.

(16) Approval of the application of Unocal for the elimination of prorating in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs pool, under present conditions, will prevent waste and will not impair correlative rights.

(17) The most practicable time at which gas prorating should be discontinued in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool would be at the expiration of the current gas proration period at 7:00 o'clock a.m., September 1, 1992.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

(1) Effective at 7:00 o'clock a.m., September 1, 1992, gas prorating is hereby discontinued in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, in Rio Arriba, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

(2) Commission Order No. R-8170, as amended, is hereby further amended to delete all references therein to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool effective at 7:00 o'clock a.m., September 1, 1992.

(3) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


