Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne"), for its application,
states:

1. Mewbourne is the operator of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. Mewbourne operates the Chalk Bluff Federal No. 1 Well ("the No. 1 Well"), located 2250 feet FWL and 790 feet FSL, to which the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 1 is dedicated. The No. 1 Well is completed in and is producing from the Morrow formation (North Illinois Camp-Morrow Gas Pool).

3. The No. 1 Well is not capable of draining 320 acres.

4. Mewbourne requests permission to drill an infill well in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1 to test the Morrow formation, to dedicate the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 1 to the proposed well and to the No. 1 Well, and to produce both the proposed well and the No. 1 Well continuously and concurrently. Therefore, Mewbourne requests an exception to Division Rule 104(C)(2)(b).

5. Mewbourne also requests an unorthodox location of 1980 feet FSL and 990 feet FEL for its proposed infill well.


6. The granting of this application is in the interest of conservation, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

7. Mewbourne requests that this matter be heard at the October 1, 1992 Examiner hearing.

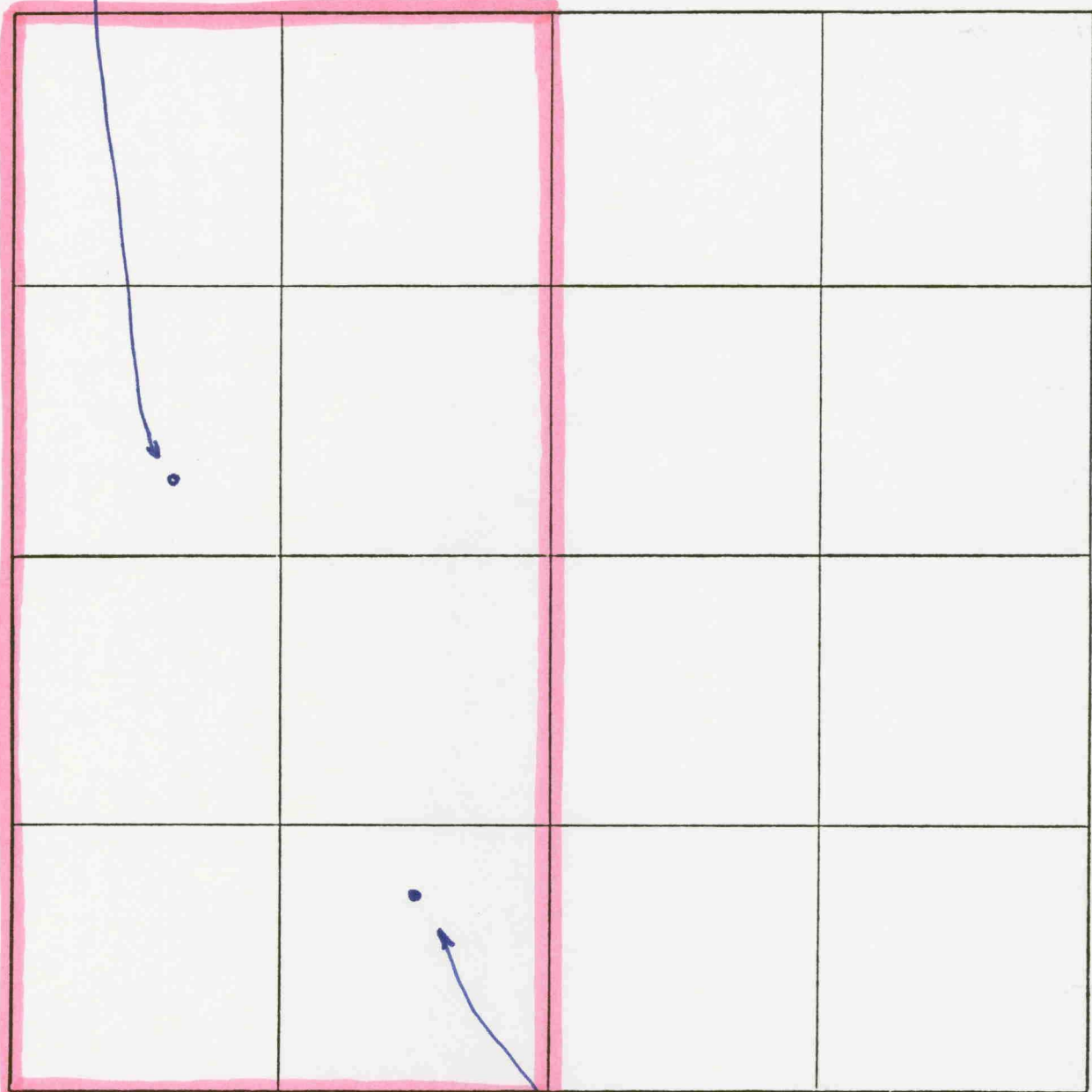
