

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

Gentlemen:

A cement bond log was run October 19, 1993, on the above referenced well in accordance with the provisions of Division Order R-9802, permitting disposal into the J. G. Cox Well No. 1 located in Unit C of Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

The log was witnessed by Oil Conservation Division personnel; however, the bond log confirmed that cement coverage is not sufficient to cover the injection interval in the J. G. Cox Well No. 1.

We request that you conform to Division Order R-9802, by perforating the V. F. Cox Well No. 1, at the top of the San Andres formation and block squeeze to insure that disposal of water is confined to the approved injection interval in the water disposal well.

We request 24 hours notice prior to the procedure in order to witness the operation.

We request that you have this procedure completed and approved no later than November 19, 1993.



Dear Mr. Rogers:

Reference is made to your request dated June 7, 1993 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above-referenced well. This request is based on a step rate tests conducted on this well on June 4, 1993. The results of the test has been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Well and Location	Maximum Injection Surface Pressure
J.G. Cox SWD Well No. 1 660' FNL & 1980' FWL Unit C, Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 38 East	1112 PSIG
This well is located in Lea County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
