APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company hereby makes application for an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Abo formation to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the $E^{1/2}_{2}$ of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner and has the right to drill a well in the E_2^1 of said Section 35.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Chalk Bluff "35" Federal No. 1 Well in the E_2^1 of Section 35, at an orthodox location, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and seeks to dedicate the E_2^1 of Section 35 to the well.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to join all other mineral or leasehold interest owners in the E^{1}_{2} of Section 35 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although Applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral or leasehold interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their acreage. Therefore, Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral and leasehold interest owners underlying the E^1_{2} of Section 35, as described above, pursuant to $JGBS \setminus 92644.d$

N.M. Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17 (1987 Repl.).

5. Applicant requests the Division to consider the cost of drilling and completing the well, the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision. Applicant requests that it ge designated as operator of the well and that the Division set a penalty of 200% for the risk involved in drilling the well.

6. The pooling of all interests underlying the $E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of Section 35, as described above, will prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Division grant the relief requested above.
