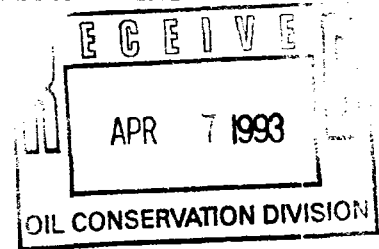

STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

See Applicant's filing.

INTERESTED PARTY:

Meridian Oil Inc. is a working interest owner in the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool and has property interests in the section adjoining the proposed Amoco project.

Meridian Oil Inc. is a party in this case affected by the granting of this application.

If the Division should grant this application, then Meridian requests the Division require Amoco to file with the Division, with a copy to Meridian Oil Inc, the following:

(a) On a monthly basis all injection rates, injection volumes and injection pressures itemized by substances and tabulated on a daily basis for any injection well;

(b) On a monthly basis all production rates, production volumes and production pressures (measured as surface tubing head pressures) itemized by substance and tabulated on a daily basis for each producing well offsetting the project injection well;

(c) Upon commencement of injection, Amoco shall conduct an initial injectivity profile survey with tagged radioactive tracer material and within five days thereof, file with the Division, copy to Meridian Oil Inc. said survey, its results and all supporting data therefor.

(d) Thereafter for the file of the project and at regular intervals of not more than 60-days each, Amoco shall conduct subsequent injectivity profile surveys with tagged

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radioactive tracer material and within five days thereof, file with the Division, copy to Meridian Oil Inc. said survey, its results and all supporting data therefor.

(e) Prior to commencement of injection, Amoco shall obtain and file with the Division production profile logging reports performed on any offsetting wells to the injection well; and

(f) In the event of carbon dioxide breakthrough in any offsetting producing well, Amoco shall report said occurrence within seven (7) calendar days thereof to the Division, copy to Meridian Oil Inc.


