
Dear Mr. Bruce:

NOW, on this 8th day of June, 1993, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,


FINDS THAT:

- (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


