MR. CARROLL: In the matter of Case 10777 being reopened pursuant to the provisions of Division Order No. R-9775, as amended, which order established a 560 barrel of oil per day temporary oil allowable for the North Teague-Ellenburger Pool in Lea County.

MR. CARR: May it please the examiner, my name is William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr, Berge & Sheridan. We represent Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc., in this matter.

During the period of the temporary rules for the North Teague-Ellenburger Pool, information has been obtained which establishes that a special oil allowable of 560 barrels a day is not needed. Texaco, therefore, will present no testimony in this case and recommends that the temporary rules expire and that this pool now be operated under statewide rule.
