3 MR. CARROLL: In the matter of Case 10777
4 being reopened pursuant to the provisions of Division
5 Order No. R-9775, as amended, which order established
6 a 560 barrel of oil per day temporary oil allowable
7 for the North Teague-Ellenburger Pool in Lea County.

8 EXAMINER CATANACH: Are there appearances
9 in this case?

10 MR. CARR: May it please the examiner, my
11 name is William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm
12 Campbell, Carr, Berge & Sheridan. We represent
13 Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc., in this
14 matter.

15 Mr. Examiner, Texaco was the original
16 applicant in this case. During the period of the
17 temporary rules for the North Teague-Ellenburger
18 Pool, information has been obtained which establishes
19 that a special oil allowable of 560 barrels a day is
20 not needed. Texaco, therefore, will present no
21 testimony in this case and recommends that the
22 temporary rules expire and that this pool now be
23 operated under statewide rule.

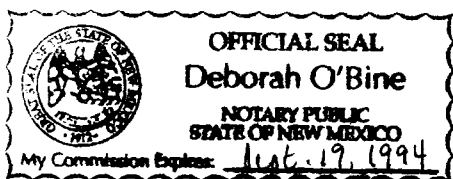
