

By letter dated July 26, 1993, Nearburg proposed the drilling of the captioned well. Because of topographic reasons, the BLM has required that we move the location to 990' from the west and north lines of Section 10 rather than that proposed in my July 26th letter. Originally, the well was located 990' FWL and 800' FNL of Section 10. The original AFE furnished to you in my July 26th letter is still applicable.
