> Request for Extension of Well Commencement Deadline, Order No. R-9904

Dear Mr. LeMay:

The above order pooled the N1 of § 18 - 20 South - 34 East for a Morrow test well at an orthodox location, and fixed a commencement deadline of September 1, 1993. Santa Fe Energy Operating Partners, L.P. (Santa Fe), the operator under the order, hereby requests that the well commencement deadline be extended to November 1, 1993. The reasons for this request are as follows:

- Santa Fe applied for an APD for the well with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) on February 3, 1993. The first page of the APD is attached as Exhibit A.
- The APD was denied by the BLM on July 1, 1993, because of possible potash mineralization at the proposed location (the proposed well is in the oil-potash area). No potash lessee had objected to the location. The BLM's denial letter is attached as Exhibit B.
- Santa Fe subsequently filed a new APD, and has been verbally informed by the BLM that the location is acceptable.

The hearing on the compulsory pooling application was held May 20, 1993. JGB5\93F18.c

4. The new location is 2,210 feet from the North and East lines of Section 18, requiring Santa Fe to obtain approval of an unorthodox gas well location from the Division, as well as the amendment of Order No. R-9904 to allow the pooled unit to be dedicated to a well at the unorthodox location. Santa Fe is in the process of applying to the Division for approval of the unorthodox location, and the hearing will be set for 8:15 a.m. on September 23, 1993 at the Division's offices at 310 Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Based on the foregoing, Santa Fe needs additional time to secure BLM final approval of the APD, obtain unorthodox location approval, prepare the site for drilling, and commence drilling. Therefore, Santa Fe requests that the commencement date (and the completion date) be extended by two months.

By copies of this letter, Santa Fe is notifying the two parties pooled under Order No. R-9904 of this request, and of the upcoming hearing date.
