



Conoco has requested a special gas:oil ratio of 6000:1 for the  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of § 27 - 21 South - 37 East (Paddock Pool), to allow wells thereon to produce at capacity for a 12 month period.

Exxon opposes Conoco's request. Exxon makes no assertion regarding the application from the standpoint of waste. However, if the Division determines no waste will occur if Conoco's request is granted, Exxon asserts that the correlative rights of offset lessees in the Pool will be adversely affected unless the GOR increase requested by Conoco is adopted for the entire Pool.
