MITCHELL ENERGY CORPORATION'S STATEMENT OF CASE

MITCHELL ENERGY CORPORATION ("Mitchell") objects to the Yates Energy Corporation application and requests the Division deny the Yates' request.

Mitchell will demonstrate that:

- (1) Approval of Yates' application will allow Yates' to crowd the Mitchell's Atoka gas well in the E/2 of Section 13, T22S, R30E, NMPM;
- (2) Yates' unorthodox gas well location cannot be justified based upon geologic reasons;
- (3) There are standard locations available to Yates within its proposed spacing unit which will provide to Yates an adequate and efficient opportunity to produce its share of recoverable hydrocarbons;

- (4) The Yates requested unorthodox well location if approved will give Yates an unfair advantage over the offsetting interest owners and will violate correlative rights;
- (5) Yates is using the presumed presence of potash as an excuse to gain an unfair and unnecessary advantage over Mitchell and other adjoining owners.
- (6) Yates' application should be denied because it is geologically and economically feasible to drill a directional well to a standard subsurface location.
