FINDS THAT:

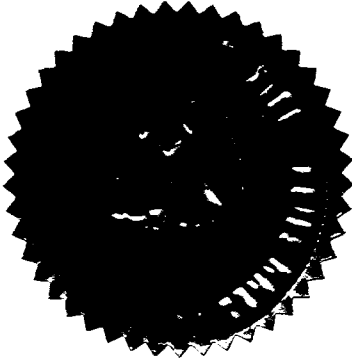
Sun Exploration and Production Company, as applicant in this case, has requested dismissal thereof and such request should be granted.
