COMES NOW, MERIDIAN OIL. INC., by and through its attorneys. Kellahin, Kellahin and Aubrey, and in accordance with Section 70-2-17(c) NMSA (1978) applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order pooling all mineral interest in the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool underlying the E/2 of Section 21, T31N, R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico. 
