COMES NOW MERIDIAN OIL INC., by and through its attorneys, KELLAHIN, KELLAHIN & AUBREY, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox oil well location for production from any oil pool spaced on 40 acres, including the Shugart Pool (Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg), for its Benson "3" Federal No. 7 well to be drilled to the base of the Grayburg formation, at an unorthodox location 330 feet from the East line and 1140 feet from the South line of Section 3, T19S, R30E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico with the dedication of a standard spacing and proration unit thereto consisting of 40 acres, more or less, being the SE/4SE/4 of said Section 3 and in support states:

- 1. Applicant, Meridian Oil Inc., is the operator of and has the right to drill and develop the SE/4SE/4 of Section 3, T19S, R30E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 2. Applicant had proposed to develop said spacing unit by the drilling of a well at a standard well location in said Section 3 but was unable to satisfy the Bureau of Land Management as to surface use, or AMAX Potash Corp., the potash lessee, as to the subsurface use.
- 3. The unorthodox well location is sought to satisfy the BLM and potash lessee's considerations in developing this spacing unit.
