Q Just generally, what is Union seeking in that application?

A Okay. Union Oil is seeking approval of the Brown State Unit to drill a proposed 12,500 foot Brown State 28-1.

This well will be located 660 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the east line of Section 28 in Township 15 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
