3 MR. RAMEY: Mr. Kellahin, what
4 is your pleasure in Case 8191?

5 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Chairman, I
6 have reviewed again the application we have filed on behalf
7 of Cities Service Oil & Gas Corporation. We believe that
8 that application is slightly inconsistent with the
9 statements I've made to you insofar as the application has
10 some boundaries that are determined simply because of
11 ownership.

12 We think that spacing cases
13 ought to be decided based upon geologic and engineering
14 reasons and that we do not part out windows or delete
15 acreage simply because of surface ownership.

16 And therefore, at this point, I
17 see that there will be substantial need for revision of that
18 application and we would request that that application be
19 dismissed at this point without prejudice.

20 MR. RAMEY: Upon your request
21 the application will be dismissed without prejudice, Mr.
22 Kellahin.

23 The hearing is adjourned.
