3. Applicant anticipates being able to process approximately 50,000 to 60,000 bbls of raw material per year the first year. Of this volume, Applicant expects to reclaim approximately (200) bbls of salable crude oil per day.

4. Waste water will be collected and trucked to a disposal site.

5. If this Application is approved, before beginning actual operations, Applicant will file with the Division a performance bond in the amount of \$10,000. conditioned upon substantial compliance with applicable statutes of the State of New Mexico and all rules, regulations and Orders of the Oil Conservation Division.

6. Applicant will comply with all requirements and regulations of the Environmental Improvement Agency, and a copy of this Application is being forwarded to said Agency.

7. That the proposed plant and method of processing will efficiently process, treat, and reclaim sediment oil, thereby salvaging oil which would otherwise be wasted.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests Orders of the Oil Conservation Division as follows:


1. That this matter be set for hearing before an examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Division and that due notice thereof be given as required by law; and
