APPLICATION

Coastal Oil & Gas Corporation, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox oil well location, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for an oil well to be drilled to a proposed depth of 9,900 feet from the surface in the Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian field in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 14 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant proposes to drill the well 990 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of the Section.

3. The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5 is to be dedicated to the well.

4. Approval of the unorthodox location will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

5. Applicant requests the setting of this matter for the regular Examiner hearing on June 6, 1984.
