- 1. Applicant seeks approval of an unorthodox well location for an oil well to be drilled to a proposed depth of 9,900 feet from the surface in the Tulk Pennsylvanian field in the SEI/4 of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the well 1980 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of the Section.
 - 3. The SEI/4 of Section 27 is to be dedicated to the well.
- 4. Approval of the unorthodox location will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.
- 5. Applicant requests the setting of this matter for the regular Examiner hearing on June 6, 1984.
